

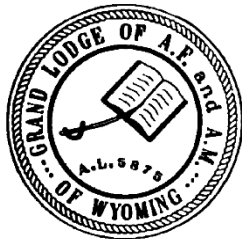
Additional Addendum (Addendum 17 April 2020) to Edict (TH-004) of 4 April 2020


This variation to the Wyoming Masonic Code Sec. 674 is to assist Lodges in clearing members for being in arrears on their dues for two years or more, as of 27 December 2019.

It is my order that Lodges may use the following guidance.

1. If a Lodge has a member or members who are in arrears on dues for two years or more, as of 27 December 2019, they shall be subject to suspension. If the required written notice has already been sent out, then “if within one month from the date of mailing such notice he fails to pay his dues or appear and show cause why he should not be suspended, such member shall be deemed suspended without further action by the lodge...”
2. If a Lodge Secretary has not received an order to suspend a member under the provisions of Sec 674 (a) by the Worshipful Master at a regular communication, the order by the Worshipful Master can be given by written and verbal communication, by notifying (via email and video conference) as many members of the Lodge as possible. Also, that during the next regular and special communications of the Lodge that this information be restated and these actions entered into the minutes of these meetings.
3. If this is an action that is taken by your Lodge, the Secretary will attach a copy of this Addendum with the minutes of your next regular Lodge communication.
